"Until it is in," he added, "we cannot say what will happen. If it is affirmed there will be a wage movement."

William G. Lee, president of the trainmen, was equally non-committal and declared he would have nothing to say until the vote was counted.

Where some of the labor representatives and the railroad officials seem to differ is in the interest of the public in the situation, which will be presented if the unions make the demand, as they are almost certain to do, judging from the way the vote is going on the referendum. Because of the unprecedented scope and character of the proposed demand, involving every mile of railroad in this country, the railroad executives and managers, it was said yesterday, were willing to concede that the public interest would be injured if strike broke the railroads themselves.

The reason for this lies primarily, they contend, in the fact that with a growing population and a steadily increasing business of the country, already several lines ahead of the railroads, the cost of living is sure to jump and all the public must bear the burden and the cost of the United States is affected.

And more than that, with a railroad plant unable to move the ordinary business of the country because of lack of facilities, any idea of railroad preparedness for a national emergency would be out of the question. Thus, a S. N. reporter was told yesterday by several of the most conservative railroad men, that the business of the country when the public must bear the burden and the cost of the United States is affected.

As this situation was detailed, the country's transportation facilities have been in the last few years falling rapidly behind the growth of business due to the increasing population. The same requirements to keep up have been variously estimated. One calculation made yesterday put this sum at about \$5,000,000 a mile. For 25,000 miles this would mean \$125,000,000 spent each year for years.

In a report made by Samuel W. Fairchild, chairman of the committee on internal trade and improvement of the New York Chamber of Commerce, made a few years ago, it was estimated that the railroads needed to spend on improvements to bring them up to traffic requirements in five years a total of \$5,000,000,000. At the time this estimate was made it was more than three times their annual gross revenues and nearly ten-fold their net income.

Unfortunately, according to those conversant with this situation, this need has been obscured in the last few years because of the business depression, which overtook the country.
