

**B. R. T. UNION MEN  
SEEK HYLAN'S AID**

Mayor Is Asked to Intervene to Forestall Brotherhood.

Disaffected employees of the B. R. T. turned yesterday to Mayor Hylan as their most logical advocate in forcing the company to declare a "closed shop."

They asked the Mayor to act as conciliator and arbitrator "in order to prevent serious consequences."

They altered their attitude somewhat by openly accusing the B. R. T. of fostering an "outlaw" union or brotherhood. Though the Mayor has not yet said whether he would serve in the capacity of mediator, he forwarded another letter to Lindsey M. Garrison, receiver of the B. R. T., calling upon the company to stop "brotherhooding."

This had reference to charges that the spokesman for the rival union, against which the company already has declared it cannot consistently take action, have been going among the men and persuading that those who fail to join the new brotherhood will lose their jobs. But Mr. Garrison had characterized this charge as one put forth to cloud the real issue.

When the brotherhood pointed out was the real issue—forcing the company to state of its own will on a "closed shop"—was evaded by the Mayor, who wrote to the receiver that "the committee that called on me at City Hall said nothing about a closed or open shop, but said that strikers and others in an official capacity were telling the men that if they did not join an organization which was being formed they would soon lose their jobs."

"I have no interest one way or the other in organization," continued the letter. "It would be the easiest thing in the world for you to see to it that those mentioned in my letter to you discontinue this method of 'brotherhooding' such as the case this, according to my understanding from the committee that called, will be sufficient to prevent a strike."
