

**ARCHBISHOP MANNIX
WARMLY GREETED**

Australian Prelate to Be Guest at Public Reception in This City To-night.

Archbishop Daniel J. Mannix of Australia upon his arrival in this city yesterday declared that after visiting and speaking in the principal cities of the United States he felt confident that the sentiment of the American people favors recognition of the "Republic of Ireland." The greater part of his audience, he admitted, were made up of Irish sympathizers, but even recognizing that fact, he said that "if any British politician rests his hopes on a lack of genuine Irish spirit in the United States he will be sadly disappointed." The Archbishop came down the Hudson from Albany and at the Forty-second street pier was met by a reception committee and several hundred other persons, who sent up cheers as soon as the tall figure of the Australian divine was in sight. On the reception committee were Archbishop Patrick J. Hayes, Father Timothy J. Shanley, Father William Livingstone, Mr. John J. Dunn, Mr. James J. Flood and Vice-General Joseph F. Mooney. The following officers of the old Sixty-ninth Regiment were present: Lieut-Col. T. J. Moynahan, Major Michael A. Kelley, Major Martin H. Meaney and Lieut. John H. Burke.

With the Archbishop were Father Albert Vaughan, his secretary, and Bishop Daniel Foley, also of Australia. At every stop on the trip down the river the Archbishop's party was greeted with cheers. The orchestra on the boat played Irish airs at frequent intervals. To-night at Madison Square Garden Archbishop Mannix will be the guest at a public reception. Archbishop Hayes and Esmonde de Valera, president of the "Republic of Ireland," will be on the platform with the Australian Archbishop and will speak. The visiting prelate declared that he stood unequivocally for the Irish Republic. De Valera he characterized as "an earnest, prudent man who knows his business." Archbishop Mannix made it plain that his tour of the United States has no political significance. He came through the United States, he said, because it is the best and nearest way to get to Rome. He has nothing but praise for America. "In my trip across the country," he said, "I was profoundly impressed by the abundance of material wealth and by the moral greatness of the people. I came prepared to see a wonderful nation, but when I got as far as Detroit the whole thing was amazing—absolutely overwhelming." "In Australia I had heard that Americans were boastful, and I had reasoned that they probably had reason to be that way, but now I can say that they are far too modest in their estimate of themselves and the splendor of their Republic." Prayers said for Eugene.
