CANADIAN MARKET RECOVERS QUICKLY

Drastic Shake-Out Is Followed by Good News of Crop Conditions.

Special to THE SUN AND NEW YORK HERALD. TORONTO, Aug. 16.—A decided recovery in the Canadian stock market during the past week followed the drastic shake-out of a few days earlier. Coincided with confirmation of good news regarding Western crops. Now that the binders have actually started operations on the prairie the success of the year's operations amounts to a certainty, though it is recognized, of course, that the long dry period of early July reduced the ultimate harvest by many millions of bushels.

BETTER SERVICE OUT OF CANADA

Steamship Lines Made Sole Agents for United States Mail Steamship Co.

Special to THE SUN AND NEW YORK HERALD. MONTREAL, Aug. 16.—On the return to the city of J. W. Norcross, president of the Canada Steamship Lines, Ltd., it was learned that an important arrangement had been effected for the establishment of a more complete service for the handling of freight and passenger traffic out of Canada.

By the Canada Steamship Lines are appointed the sole passenger and freight agents in Canada of the United States Mail Steamship Company. The latter is a large corporation which has recently taken over from the United States Government a very considerable number of former German passenger and freight vessels. The new company is now operating out of a number of ports in the United States.

NEW RATE INQUIRY UP IN DOMINION

Officials of All Big Roads Appear Before the Railway Commission.

OTTAWA, Aug. 16.—In the last week Ottawa has found its chief source of interest in a freight rate inquiry by the Dominion Railway Commission. Early in July the Canadian railways, acting conjointly through the Railway Association of Canada, made application for a 30 per cent. all round increase in freight rates.

When the Railway Labor Board at Washington awarded an extensive increase of wages to all railway employees it was inevitable that the new schedules should be made applicable to Canada and the railway executives immediately declared that a 30 per cent. increase would under the changed circumstances be quite inadequate to their needs.
