

**'LITTLE ENTENTE'
SPLIT OVER DANUBE**

Smaller Nations to Get Equal
Voice in Control of
Waterway.

FRENCH ACTION DISLIKED

Rumanians and Serbians Com-
plain That Free Use of River
Was Hampered.

PARIS, Sept. 11.—The "Little En-
tente" (Rumania, Czechoslovakia and
Yugo-Slavia), like its elder sister, is be-
ginning to experience diplomatic dis-
agreements as a result of divergence of
opinion with regard to how the Danube

shipping will be controlled. The Dan-
ubian conference early last summer tem-
porarily accepted the French scheme for
the internationalization of that water-
way, details of which have never been
published, but as the alliance of the
countries bordering on the Danube was
formed, opposition developed to what the
Rumanians and the Serbians asserted
was an effort by the French to obtain
material advantages, instead of allow-
ing a free and liberal use of Central
Europe's only available deep water-
way.

Representation on the Danube Com-
mission's delegations was, according to
the smaller nations interested, not com-
mensurate with their national interests
and therefore a new scheme of repre-
sentation has been devised which will
give them an equal voice in the control
of the Danube ports and the supervision
of that waterway.

At the Paris headquarters of the
Danube Commission officials refused to
comment on the situation that is re-
garded as awkward, but the correspond-
ent of THE SUN AND NEW YORK HERALD
was informed that conversations had
been broken off in connection with this
matter until Take Jonescu, Rumanian
representative, discusses Rumania's de-
mands when he meets Premier Millerand
in Aix-les-Bains soon.

In well informed quarters here it was
admitted that there was great danger
that the Serbs and Rumanians would
leave the conference unless the French
concede a more equitable solution of the
Danube problem.
