CIRCULAR. Some time since a circular was addressed to you, to ensure the execution of the law providing for the inspection of produce; but it is to be regretted that, by your failure to carry out its provisions, you have allowed...

Hogs and provisions are less firm, but prices are unchanged. New York light exchange has declined to 1/2 a 3/4 cent.
