

THE FAMINE IN GREAT BRITAIN.

Death of an English Weaver From Want of Food—Wretched Wages of His Trade and His Beliefs.

Yesterday forenoon Mr. H. Bates Walthow, the Deputy Coroner for Middlesex, held an inquest at Bethnal Green on the body of Thomas Williams, aged sixty-six years, a Scitland weaver, who had died on the 14th of May.

The widow said that her husband and herself occupied one small room, and that their joint earnings only amounted to about a shilling a week, and that they had to pay rent and purchase food and fuel. He lately could only do a little at the loom, and the work was very badly paid.

Mr. Walthow asked the jury to return a verdict in the case of the deceased, and the jury returned a verdict in the medical testimony.
