

FINANCIAL AND COMMERCIAL.

The gold market has been moderately active, but with only slight variations in price, all the demand was chiefly from the "shorts," to close contracts, and as this indicated the tendency was towards lower figures.

The stock market was active in the bear interest, at the first hour and the nearly steady decline which has been the main feature of the stock exchange for a long time past made further progress.

At the open board at one o'clock the market was lower. At the second regular board the depression was greater. Reading showed a decline from the morning price of 3/4.

After the call Erie declined to 7 3/4, and the bears predicted a special call to the stock exchange and to be derived from a certain well known operator on the street, who some time back is believed to have agreed with the Erie Railroad Company to lend the latter three millions of dollars, accepting as collateral security twenty thousand shares and one million of four percent mortgage bonds.

The supply of money on call is abundant at seven per cent; the disbursements of the Treasury, the large balances remaining with the national banks, and the return flow from the West, contributing severally to the prevailing ease.

The transactions in foreign exchange are light, and likely to continue so. The export of cotton and other Southern produce will soon begin to tell upon the market, both here and abroad.

The cash balance in the hands of the Assistant Treasurer at the close of business, January 14, was \$5,383,433.38—an increase of \$265,599.00 on the preceding week.
