The State Election To-Day—The Contest in New York.

Elections for State officers and a Legislature, and also for a Governor, excepting New York, take place in each of the following States to-day, viz:—Massachusetts, New York, New Jersey, Wisconsin and Minnesota.

Throughout the country, however, there is a lively interest manifested in and considerable importance attached to the contest in New York and the issue in New Jersey.

The sharpest and most actively contested canvass of the season has been that of New Jersey, where the republicans, under the famous cavalry leader Kilpatrick, have been vigorously fighting to revolutionize the State.

With the election, therefore, of another democratic Legislature in New Jersey, it is probable that the refusal of her last Legislature to ratify said amendment will be repeated, while the success of the republicans will secure the ratification.

Upon this issue, and upon the labors of General Kilpatrick among the soldiers, the republicans expect to carry the State.

In New York the republicans last November, upon the unparalleled popular vote of seven hundred and thirty thousand, had a majority of seven thousand—a close run—and we understand that the subsequent changes from either party to the other have been very few.

What, then, is the meaning of this extraordinary political struggle? It means the preliminary marshalling of the republican forces and the democratic forces, upon what they have discovered to be the most available platform, for the next Presidential campaign.
