The several reasons why "portable rafts" and immovable "life boats" should be deemed sufficient to create a feeling of safety are practically and obviously absurd. That they, expensive as being considered, would occupy so much necessary space, and when not actually needed absolutely be in the way, is an objection; and to supply the place of disabled life boats save life boats would be required. Thus there would be no end of boats; though I do not propose to depend upon rafts...
