CUBA.

A Spanish Bombast—Captain General de Rodas Proclaims the Reduction of the Insurgents to be Fully Tried by Courts Martial or by Civil Tribunals.

HAVANA, July 7, 1869.

Captain General de Rodas has issued an important proclamation. He states that the insurrection has been reduced in extent, and is now carried on by parties of guerrillas. He declares that parties arrested for robbery, arson or murder shall be tried by court martial, while in other cases the civil tribunals shall continue to exercise their functions; and he declares that the accused may rely upon receiving impartial justice.

ENGLAND.

The London Press on the Irish Church Bill.

LONDON, July 7, 1869. The Daily News (liberal) has an editorial article to-day on the proceedings of the House of Lords last evening. The writer says that the Irish Church bill is a character from which it caters, and much less accountable to the country. It will be quite impossible for the House of Commons to accept the amendments made by the Lords, and it will be their duty to restore the bill in its original form. LOUISIANA.

The Sugar Seizures in New Orleans—Shipments of Wheat to France.

NEW ORLEANS, July 7, 1869. A large quantity of sugar of Auguste, Coutouré & Co. have been claimed by the Havana firm of Pissava, Aviles & Co. Coutouré & Co. have suspended payments to the Havana firm, and the latter has obtained a writ of injunction against the sugar belonging to the latter.
