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UNITED STATES COMMISSIONER'S COURT.

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The witness testified that the foregoing statement of the defendant at Hamamass, Pa., that he had committed an act of bankruptcy, nor did he make any conveyance with the intent to make a preference that Yule did falsely swear in the taking of a certain affidavit that upon the 6th of June, 1868, he (Vose) had a conversation with one of the members of the firm mentioned in the course of which David Yule admitted that on the 6th of June, 1868, Yule, being indebted to the firm in the sum of \$20,000, conveyed to the firm in satisfaction of the debt certain real estate in Hamamass, Pa., that the payment was received in payment at the rate of fifty cents on the dollar, and that the property having been subsequently sold, the sum of \$8,000 was realized, all of which witness now testified was actually paid to the firm.

The defendant, Vose, was held under bail to await examination on Monday.
