The morning broke bright and beautiful, but before the time arrived to make the preliminary arrangements for such an important occasion the sky was overcast, and the dull, leaden clouds made the heat oppressive, and what little wind came from the north-northwest was so light as to be scarcely perceptible in the hearts of the officers and captains of the fleet. No wind! The thought was, "What does a no-wind day mean? It means that the breeze is blowing at that blue sky and bright sunshine are well enough in their places, but they are secondary matters when the wind is so light that you can scarcely get the sails to fill. But there was a breeze, and, although not as fresh as could have been desired, was sufficient to develop the racing spirit of the yachtsmen, and each had his full share of excitement and joy.

As early as nine o'clock many of the yachts had left the harbor, and were seen in the distance. At a point between the Delaplace House and Hunt's Dock, Long Island, meaning to be well placed at the moment of starting.
