

THE COURTS.

Charge of Perjury in Bankruptcy Dismissed—Alleged Revenue Frauds—Heavy Suit for Damages—Corps Eric Litigation—A Habeas Corpus Case—Ferry Case—in the General Sessions.

UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT—IN BANKRUPTCY. A Charge of Perjury Against a Petitioner Dismissed.

Before Judge Blackford. In the case of Robert H. Freeman, formerly proprietor of the Washington Hotel, No. 375 Fourth avenue, some of his creditors opposed his discharge in bankruptcy, on the grounds that he had committed perjury in making out the schedules attached to the petition in bankruptcy, by purposely making them incomplete, and averring to them as correct and fully paid, and concealing some of the property to prevent his creditors from getting it; had fraudulently converted other portions of it to cheat his creditors; had not kept proper books of account; had destroyed some of his books and papers to conceal frauds; had removed other of his books and papers for the same purpose; and had by a money consideration, secured the assent of some of his creditors to his discharge in bankruptcy. Judge Blackford holds that some of the allegations are not made out, by the evidence, and that the application is granted. The discharge is to be entered as soon as the Register certifies on the part of the bankrupt with the technical provisions of the law.

Deceit Ordered. Judge Blackford has ordered decrees to be entered against the British steamer Queen and bark Juno for some thousands of dollars worth of goods brought aboard the vessel, and to be sold to satisfy the liens unless prompt payment is made of the amount thereof.

UNITED STATES COMMISSIONER'S COURT. Another Revenue Case. Before Commissioner Shields.

The United States vs. Solomon Ray.—The defendant in this case is a cigar dealer and is charged with defrauding the government by using of cancelled stamps. The particulars have been fully published in the Herald. The case was concluded and the Commissioner reserves his opinion.

SUPREME COURT—CIVIL DIVISION. The Erie Railroad Litigation—Heavy Suit for Damages.

Before Judge Barnard. The Erie Railway Company vs. The Lake Shore and Michigan Southern Railroad Company and the New York Central and Hudson River Railroad Company.—The complaint in this action states that the track of the Erie Railroad is six feet in width, while that of the Central Railroad and its connections is only four feet eight and a half inches, rendering it impossible for the cars of one line to run on the track of the other.
