

THE LOVES OF THE TAILORS.

The "Green-Eyed Monster" and His Ravages in Sixth Street.

A LUDICROUS SCENE IN COURT.

At about three o'clock yesterday afternoon the quiet of the Essex Market Court room was suddenly disturbed by the entry of an excited crowd of Hebrew tailors and tailoresses, who came to lay their grievances before the minister of justice and seek redress for wrongs that could no longer be patiently endured.

Each claimed the privilege of making the first statement. After the question of priority had been determined and the case appeared to be as follows:—One August Beyer, of 639 Sixth street, is a married man, occupies the ground floor of that establishment as a tailor shop and employs a number of girls to assist him in his calling.

In an unsuspecting hour, while the errand August Beyer was returning from his usual haunts, the host of his character, Rachel, discovered the twin, and, utterly regardless of the proprieties of time and place, ruthlessly forced her rival to the floor and drove the money market into a state of confusion.

THE PUBLIC HOSPITALS.

A Canard Exploded—An Abundance of Medicines and Food for Patients.

An effort has been made by a morning paper to further alarm the public by the publication yesterday of many absurd statements regarding the public hospitals of the city, whose patients, it is claimed, are suffering for necessary medical supplies or money wherewith to purchase them.

A visit was yesterday made to the hospitals and the office of the Commissioners of Charities and Correction with a view of ascertaining what effect the municipal muddle has upon them, and it was ascertained that there is no ground for complaint.

The authorities at the headquarters, corner of Nassau street and Third avenue, declare that the inmates of the hospitals shall not suffer for anything necessary to their comfort and recovery, as money intended for the purchase of medicine in case of an emergency arising, can be devoted to the purchase of medicine and supplies.

MRS. DE CONNOLLY'S INSANITY.

Mrs. Ellen Connolly, wife of the late Dr. James J. Connolly, who murdered himself and two children at their residence in June last, was arrested by Boundman Crocker, of the Twenty-ninth precinct, on Wednesday night, upon complaint of her friends, charged with insanity.

FINANCIAL AND COMMERICAL.

WALL STREET, FRIDAY, OCT. 6—5 P. M.

On 'Change to-day wheat fell and lower. The cotton market was firm and a shade better. Money was easy as five to six per cent on government and at six to seven per cent on stocks.

Prime commercial paper running sixty days is quoted at 7 1/2 per cent discount. FOREIGN EXCHANGE ACTIVE AND HIGHER.

Foreign exchange was temporarily heavy at the opening of business in consequence of the sharp demand for cash gold, but became active and strong later in the day, in response to the reports of an active and excited money market in London.

A feverish and excited market prevailed in the Gold Room throughout the day, sudden and wide changes being caused by the successive reports of varying tenor from London. The earliest recorded sales were at 114 1/2, arising out of a supplementary report by the cable that in addition to the large loss of reserve in the weekly statement of the Bank of England a further sum of £1,000,000 had been taken out on Thursday.

Less effect would have been produced here had this money turned up in Paris, but the bank of France showing to-day a loss of 11,000,000 francs the conclusion became inevitable that the drain of specie was going further into the Continent, and was destined for Germany.

The bank rate in London was 10 per cent, since the Treasury despatch made on 29th Sept. that the great tax for money is fully five per cent a condition of affairs which has suggested a rumor that a special meeting of the Bank of England will be held on Monday morning to put the minimum. The effect on consols has been a decline of 1/4 to 1/2 per cent, but five-twenties have held up better. The new funding five per cent was, however, quoted at a discount of 3/4 per cent, and later at two per cent discount.

The agents of the Syndicate in this city again deny emphatically that there has been any default on the part of the foreign subscribers. The second series of despatches from London reported a better feeling, and gold suddenly ran down to 114 1/2; but here exchange began to stiffen, and as the foreign banks began buying and continued buying pretty much to the close of business there was a second advance to 114 1/2, the closing dealings being at 114 1/2.

It is not so clear that it is difficult to see the real position. The money market in London has evidently been rendered exceedingly sensitive by the drain of specie to the Continent, and a heavy decline in the speculative shares of the London Stock Exchange has been felt to some extent in securities of a staid character.
