

ENGLAND.

The Tichborne Verdict Decision Endorsed by the Press.

Dr. Wainwright's Verdict—Rumor of Bail by the Marquis of Bute—Public Feeling Towards America—Outflow of Specie—Artisan and Labor Combinations.

TELEGRAMS TO THE NEW YORK HERALD.

LONDON, March 7, 1872. All the city journals this morning approve the decision in the Tichborne case.

The trial of Orton, the alleged Tichborne heir, under a criminal indictment charging him with the commission of perjury during the progress of the property case investigation in the Court of Common Pleas, will take place before the Judges of Assize in April.

ALLEGATION OF SOLVENT BAIL FOR ARTHUR. A rumor prevails throughout the city that the Marquis of Bute, one of the richest noblemen in Great Britain, and Baron Rivers, of the family of Pitts, Earl of Chatham, will furnish the bail necessary to secure the liberation from prison of the claimant to the Tichborne estate.

The report cannot be authenticated, and it is believed by some that it is set afoot for the purpose of having an effect on the value of the Tichborne bonds, which were issued by Orton and his friends on guarantee of the estate in order to raise money to defray his expenses in prosecuting the claim.

DENIAL. Sir John Duke Coleridge, counsel for the defence in the Tichborne trial, pronounces the report that the claimant has secured bail false.

PUBLIC FEELING TOWARDS THE UNITED STATES. The London Times this morning makes mention of the exceptionally friendly tone of the American press towards England.

INDUSTRIAL COMBINATION AND THE WAGES' STRIKES. The operatives in the silk factories of Leek, in Staffordshire, to the number of 3,600, have been "locked out" for refusing to accept the terms offered by the masters. This throws a third of the town's population out of work.

FOUR HUNDRED COAL MINERS OF Seaham, in the county of Durham, are on strike for higher wages.

CIVIC HONOR FROM THE CROWN. The Deputy Recorder of the city of London has received the honor of knighthood.

THE QUEEN'S VISIT TO GERMANY. The Queen will leave for Germany on the 20th inst. and return on the 16th of April.

ADMIRALTY MANAGEMENT. The report of the Commission of Inquiry on the loss of the Megara severely censures the entire administration of the Admiralty.

FLOW OF BULLION FROM THE BANK. The regular weekly statement of the Bank of England, published to-day, shows a decrease of £270,000 during the week ending March 3.

THE SCOTCH EDUCATION BILL. In the House of Commons to-night there was a long debate on the Scotch Education bill, at the close of which the bill was read the second time.

THE POPE NOT AN APPLICANT FOR SHELTER. In reply to an inquiry of Mr. Kinnaird in the House of Commons to-night Viscount Stansted, Under Secretary for the Foreign Department, stated that "the government had no knowledge of the Pope's intention to leave Rome, and that the Pope had made no application to England to place Malta or any other portion of the British dominions at his disposal."

THE UNIVERSITIES' BOAT RACE—TRAINING THE CREW. The Cambridge University boat crew have arrived at Putney and gone into training for the University race.

THE ALABAMA CLAIMS.

English Opinion of the Indirect Damages Charge and the American Position.—A Shipping Convention with the United States.

TELEGRAM TO THE NEW YORK HERALD.

LONDON, March 7, 1872. The London Times, in its article on the Alabama claims to-day, infers from the admissions made by the press of the United States that the Americans now acknowledge the extravagance of the demand for indirect damages, although they show no disposition to withdraw them from their case.

The London Times says if the fifth claim for losses by the transfer of the American commercial marine to the British flag is not abandoned, "England will declare reference to the Geneva tribunal inadmissible, which course is approved by English statesmen and jurists."

COMMERCIAL NEGOTIATIONS WITH AMERICA. Mr. Fortescue, President of the Board of Trade, announced in the House of Commons to-day that Her Majesty's government is "negotiating a shipping convention with the government of the United States."

SCOTLAND.

United States Minister Schenck in Leave in the Capital.

TELEGRAM TO THE NEW YORK HERALD.

LONDON, March 7, 1872. Hon. Robert C. Schenck, United States Minister to England, is now on a visit to Edinburgh. Yesterday he held a reception at the St. James Hotel, which was attended by a large number of the most prominent officials and residents of that city.

SELECTION OF A REPRESENTATIVE PEER. A meeting of Scottish peers was held at Holyrood to-day, at which the Marquis of Queensberry was elected to the House of Lords as representative peer of Scotland, to fill the vacancy occasioned by the death of the Earl of Kellie.
