COUNT VON ARMIN'S ARREST.

The Charge Against the Ex-Minister Dwindling Down.

[SPECIAL DESPATCH TO THE HERALD BY CABLE.] BERLIN, Oct. 18, 1874. Count Von Armin's trial will take place in three weeks.

THE CHARGE AGAINST THE COURT. The charge against the ex-Ambassador of Germany has dwindled down to one of insubordination only, Prince Bismarck dreading the further spread of the scandal.

COUNT VON ARMIN KEPT IN THE MOST STRICT CONFINEMENT.

Despatches from Berlin represent that Count Von Armin has been excluded from all communication with the outer world.

AN ENGLISH ACCOUNT OF THE ARREST. (Berlin Oct. 5—Evening) correspondence of the London Telegraph.

I have received from the best sources the following details with respect to Count Armin's arrest and imprisonment:—Yesterday afternoon the palace of Count Armin's mother-in-law, the wife of a former Minister of State, was searched, and on the morning of the 17th, when his premier lieutenant of the Dragon Guards, was similarly examined. Both investigations were conducted with great strictness, but were alike desultory.

THE EX-AMBASSADOR WAS REMOVED FROM HIS RESIDENCE BY SEVERAL MEN, some of whom were officials of the Foreign Office and some members of the police force, and he was promised that he should not be imprisoned in a prison, but that he should be voluntarily delivered up to the despatches in his own house. When the Count refused to accede to this proposal, the principal officials produced an order, already signed, for his arrest and imprisonment.
