the property was, however, subsequently received by the sheriff, and the goods are brought to recover damages for this act of invasion and injury to her business.

A motion to dismiss was made by the plaintiff, and the court holding that, even in the absence of testimony as to his helping carry away the goods, the presence with the marshall, and the fact that the goods were taken from the place, it was claimed that the circumstances surrounding the business were suspicious and justified the marshall in his action.
