POTTSVILLE, Pa., June 20, 1877.

The time is fast approaching when the "Molly Maguire" murders in the jail at this place are to be led to execution, and as the hour draws near the shadow of the coming tragedy seems to grow deeper and darker.

Anticipating no evil of any kind—no attempt at rescue, no disturbance of the peace, no outward demonstration of sympathy, even—I still look forward to the event with the kind of apprehension that comes with the knowledge that I must not only witness but assist in the death of six men by strangulation.

Sheriff Warner has been overruled with applications for writs of admission into the jail tomorrow, and he is determined that whoever is admitted shall be his deputies not only in name but in fact.

REMARKS BY THE WIFE OF THE DECEASED.

It is no wonder, then, that the jail was besieged from early morning till late at night this last day of the condemned men on earth by heartbroken mothers, bending under their weight of woe even more than under the burden of years; by grief-stricken fathers, soon to follow to the grave their dearest sons; by sorrowing wives, bearing in their hearts the curse of their husband's crimes, and by little children too young to feel the shame and sorrow and suffering of these sad partings, and joining their childish prattle with the sobbing farewells of the parents.

Before these affecting scenes began the Pottsville jail saw another sight almost as sad and foreboding as this.

This was the act of manning the gallows for the morning.

From the cell next to the gallows, a Pottsville prisoner, named and true name in hand, taking the length and girth of each in turn.
