SOCIALISTS ELECT SEVEN ALDERMEN

Tammany, 48; a Plurality of 34 Over the Republican Minority of 14.

DEMOCRAT BEATS NEGRO Foreign Born Voters on East Side, in Bronx and Brownsville Show Strength.

The Tammany control of the next Board of Aldermen will be overwhelming. Final returns show that the Democrats elected 48, the Republicans only 14 and the Socialists 7.

The Republicans elected six Aldermen in Manhattan, none in the Bronx, seven in Brooklyn, one in Queens and three in Richmond.

The Democrats captured seventeen in Manhattan, nine in the Bronx, fifteen in Brooklyn, four in Queens and three in Richmond.

The Socialists elected four in Manhattan, one in the Bronx and two in Brooklyn. The revised figures show that James C. Thomas, Jr., a negro, running on the Republican ticket in the Twenty-sixth Manhattan district, was defeated by Frank Mullen, Democrat, by a small margin.

Municipal Courts.

By far the most interesting of the Brooklyn contests was the fight for the three vacancies in the Supreme Court.
