

NORTHCLIFFE SEES ASQUITH 'SMASHED' BY CLEMENCEAU

Tells "Sun" Lloyd George's Speech Spelled Funeral of Ex-Premier. New Premier Scores Notable Victory in French Chamber of Deputies.

"OLD GANG'S" GRIP GONE TRIUMPH FOR PRIME MINISTER AND AID, MILNER, SMUTS AND GEDDES.

Appeal for Unity in Prosecution of the War Meets Notable Response.

Special Cable Despatch to THE SUN. LONDON, Nov. 21.—Lord Northcliffe, whose vigorous attacks on the old Asquith government were chiefly responsible for the elevation of Lloyd George to the Premiership, last night in an interview with THE SUN correspondent suggested tremendous political consequences that he expected, and incidentally remarked:

"I throw a bouquet to THE SUN which always has been right as to the fluctuation and trend of public opinion of the people of Great Britain toward Lloyd George."

Lord Northcliffe continued: "It is not pleasant to be present at an execution and not agreeable to witness the final smashing up of one of the ablest talkers in Europe or elsewhere. Yet that is exactly what happened last night."

The offices of the British War Mission are within two or three doors of the headquarters of Asquith and his ragged politicians, whom Lloyd George and the Old Gang, The Blinds are drawn—the place has the appearance of a funeral, and it was a funeral.

Confronts Hostile Audience. "Never was Commons so packed in its history. The most favored guests had to be contented with standing room, and the evening newspapers published in the proceedings in which the old man evidently knew what he was up against before the storm broke, for I was told that before rising he sensed the fact that he had to face not only a hostile but an indignant audience."

None of Leaders Rich. "George began life in a laborer's cottage and Gen. Smuts is a South African Boer whom we could not beat in the Boer war and who has driven the Germans out of Africa. Geddes got wised up as a lad on an American railroad and Milner is the son of a country doctor."

Some of them are a rich man. None has any pull outside of his own brains. There are other good men, but these are King George's chief advisers to-day."

His Magnetism Wins. The warmth of imagination of M. Clemenceau was in evidence in such moments some of the men whose political attitude he was attacking liberally and joyfully in his personal magnetism and joy in the outbreak of his emotions.

Before mounting the tribune to read his declaration of policy M. Clemenceau apparently was the least affected by the clamor of the tribune. Although everywhere else the feeling was tense, he succeeded in his bearing the controlling spirit of some important corporation about a meeting of the board of directors, who knows what must be done and is about to make it known when the yearly reports have been read and reported.

The Premier walked to the tribune with firm, quick steps and began speaking in short, crisp sentences. The Government's program was not only a business. He bit his words off as if to emphasize their importance by their brusqueness. After each important declaration with his own words, he declared, he resumed his reading untroubled and unswayed by the outburst of the tribune.
