

RAPIDLY VOLATILE ACTIONS IN COTTON

Market Not Only Loses Gains, but Breaks Into Low Ground in Late Trading.

While the volume of business was not particularly heavy, there has seldom been more rapid and violent fluctuations in market than what occurred in the cotton market here yesterday.

The market opened irregular at a decline of 35 points to an advance of 3 points, but the break of between 8 and 10 points was followed by a recovery to 10 points.

It was pointed out around the ring that the volume of the bull market report in succession, and early spot advances from the South were also of a more bullish average.

It seemed that early buyers felt little confidence in a sustained recovery, and the active months 40 to 52 points net lower.

Exports for the day were 2,546 bales, making 3,258,607 so far this season.

Allies Suggest They Be Eliminated to Harden American Troops' Feet.

Under a plan expected to be adopted by American army officers at the suggestion of allied heads, one pair of "light" socks will be given to each American soldier.

Soldiers will be instructed to grease their feet, the grease covering in a measure taking the place of socks.
