

ALLIES ESTABLISH LONG FRONT IN EAST

Chain of Troops Reaches From Volga in Europe to Vladivostok.

RED FORCE IS DEFEATED

Russians Aid in Capturing Bolshevik Positions South of Archangel.

London, Sept. 3.—A despatch to the Daily Mail from Harbin dated today says the vanguard of the Czech-Slovak forces from Verkhodinsk, eighty miles east of Lake Balkal, has joined the troops of Gen. Semenov on the Onon river. Gen. Dieckhoff is in telegraphic communication with the Transbaikalian Czechs.

There is now an uninterrupted chain of allied troops from Persia, on the Volga in Europe, to Vladivostok.

London, Sept. 3.—Entente allied troops in northern European Russia, aided by Russian forces, on August 21 captured the enemy's positions north of Oboserskaya, seventy-five miles south of Archangel, according to an official report issued today by the British War Office.

The captured position was consolidated and a subsequent enemy counter attack was repulsed with heavy losses.

The allied troops, including the Onon army, are reported to be distinctly favorable for the Entente Allies.

U. S. RECOGNIZES CZECHO-SLOVAKS

Commits America to Austrian Disintegration.

Washington, Sept. 3.—Formal recognition of the Czech-Slovak as a belligerent nation and the Czech-Slovak National Council as a de facto belligerent government was announced by Secretary Lansing today.

Mr. Lansing received Prof. T. G. Masaryk, President of the National Council of the Czech-Slovak and announced his recognition to the United States in much the same manner as any Entente Ambassador.

Act Is Far Reaching.

President Wilson's decision to recognize the Czech-Slovak means that the Czech-Slovak no longer are a part of the Austrian-Hungarian empire so far as the United States Government is concerned.

Recognition means, according to diplomats, that the Czech-Slovak now under Austrian rule will receive added incentive to revolt and join their oppressed brethren who have established a national government temporarily on Siberian soil.

U. S. GUN OUTPUT IS MAKING BIG STRIDE

Quantity Production Will Be Reached January 1, Says Crowell.

Adequate for Big Push

Heavy Brownings Being Turned Out at Rate of 6,000 or 7,000 a Month.

WASHINGTON, Sept. 3.—America's huge gun power program, which is to go hand in hand with the increase in man power to insure decisive victory next year, in many respects will be at the flood tide of quantity production by January 1 next.

Assistant Secretary of War Crowell, Director of Munitions, disclosed today that when the eighty divisions of American troops are ready to deliver the final crushing blow, in conjunction with our allies that summer, they will have not only the gun power adequate for such a gigantic force, but considerably more.

The Germans, it is explained, cannot increase their gun power more than they are doing or have been doing for some time, and there will be no means for them to cope with the culmination of America's artillery program.

In the matter of heavy guns—from 14 inch upward—the United States has already begun operations at once on a big gun plant at Nivelle Island, south of Pittsburgh.

There are now, Mr. Crowell said, twelve plants making gun forgings and putting the guns in rough shape. In addition there are twelve plants where guns are finished and the hoops shrunk on. Already 250 155mm. guns have been shipped to France.

The features of the artillery program outlined by Mr. Crowell are: Machine guns being turned out at a rate of between 25,000 and 30,000 a month.
