Contests for Two Seats in Senate Overshadows Fights for Lesser Offices.

GOV. EDGE IS CONFIDENT

Baird, Republican, and Hennessey, Democrat, Certain of Short Term Nominations.

The Republican and Democratic contests for the nominations for United States Senator overshadow all other primary battles. The Republicans seeking the honors are Gov. Walter E. Edge, ex-Representative Edward W. Gray and George L. Record.

The Democrats out for the nomination are Charles O'Connor Hennessey, George M. Lamont, Alexander Simpson and Frank M. Mc Dermott. Charles O'Connor Hennessey is assured of capturing the Democratic nomination for United States Senator for the short term, as he has no opposition.
