WILLARD'S LEFT EYE ISGAIN IN ACCIDENT

Strikes Monahan's Head in Spirited Exchange and Sustains Deep Gash.

MAY ANNOY HIM ON JULY 4

Dempsey Goes Through Lively Bout with Sparring Partners While 7,000 Look On.

TOLEDO, Ohio.—A cut over the left eye of Champion Jess Willard inflicted by the head of Walter Monahan causing blood to trickle down the title-holder's face, the refusal of Willard to meet Battling Levinsky in a training bout, and the narrow escape from death of Jack Sharkey, the west side bantam, and his manager Joe Wagner were the outstanding events to-day attending the preparations for the July 4 encounter.

The accident to the champion occurred in the first round of his bout with Monahan. Willard had finished polishing off Joe Hempel, and was in the midst of a spirited exchange with Monahan when their heads came together.

When they broke clear of each other it was seen that Willard was bleeding from a deep laceration on the forehead and the blood soon reddened the left side of his face. He kept on boxing until the round ended, and then the cut was tended by a helper. Willard refused to enter another round with Monahan and terminated his afternoon's work.

While the cut is not so serious as the one from which Dempsey suffered it is likely to prove an annoyance in the July 4 contest for it hardly will completely heal by that time. Willard probably will be wearing a bandage over the four remaining days of his training.

Boxers in Auto Mishap.

The escape from death of Sharkey and Wagner when their automobile was wrecked by a street car near Willard's camp was little less than miraculous.

The boxer and his manager were nearing a quiet dinner when the street car struck and started to cross the street car track.

A car was approaching, but as it was fifty feet away Sharkey, who was driving, signalled the car to stop.

The motorist apparently put on the brakes, but they failed to work and the heavy street car hit the roadster.

Sharkey and Wagner were catapulted out of the machine and rolled over and over in the dirt. The car struck them a slight wrench to Wagner's left shoulder and a bruise to Sharkey's left leg, the boys were uninjured. Their machine was completely wrecked.
