LLOYD GEORGE SEES RATIFICATION SOON

Expresses Hope It Will Come This Month. LONDON, Dec. 4.—Premier Lloyd George, speaking in the House of Commons to-day, expressed the hope that the peace treaty would be ratified before the end of the month.
