INTERNAL REVENUE DECISIONS.—As a matter of interest we give the following decisions, on questions of daily business transactions, condensed from the rulings of the Commissioner of Internal Revenue:

Who shall affix stamps to instruments of writing?—The law does not designate which of the parties to an instrument of writing shall furnish the necessary stamps...

Receipts of Attorney.—No stamp is required upon the receipt of an Attorney for a note or other claim left with him for collection.

Marriage Certificates.—A marriage certificate issued by the officiating clergyman or magistrate, to be returned to any officer of a State, County, Town, etc., to constitute part of a public record, requires no stamp...

Landlord and Tenant.—A notice from a landlord to his tenant to quit possession of premises, requires no stamp.

According to a recent revenue decision a bond to convey real estate requires stamps to the amount of twenty-five cents.
