His Honor, Judge Dreher, then gave a short resume of the points at issue and said that although the evidence was very slight against the accused yet some circumstance and evidence in the case, the truthfulness of which he was not then or afterward to pass upon, but which was entirely a matter for the jury, would hardly warrant an absolute dismissal of the prisoner.

Mr. Nathan Klotz of Summit Hill, the father of Joel Edgar Klotz, the accused, and Major Robert Klotz, of Mauch Chunk, at once entered into the necessary bail, and thus ended the first lesson of the Leinbach trial.

The people now breathe more freely, and a mighty load of doubt and uncertainty seems to have been removed from the minds of many who drew hasty and unjust conclusions from the vague and damaging rumors that like the old story of "the three black crows," have been starting the public for the past two weeks.

The hearing has forever set at rest all credibility of these unjust and idle stories and has given the people an idea of the true circumstance connected with the affair, as well as all the evidence that the Commonwealth up to this time has been able to collect together which has any bearing on the case, and unless something very unusual turns up between now and next court, Joel Edgar Klotz will go through the formula of a trial and without a doubt be pronounced "not guilty" by a jury of 12 of his own countrymen.

He will then be removed from any further suspicion, and it is the earnest wish of his family and friends that his trial may be both speedy and thorough, to forever vindicate his name from the least shadow of guilt.
