### Tobacco.

The New York Market.

Tobacco Journal, Crazy.

Nothing illustrates and confirms our oft

expressed views and predictions regarding

the insensibly high figures for the '79

Pennsylvania crop than the sale of 1,500

cases of '79 Wisconsin to a large cigar

manufacturing firm of this city during the

past week. A few weeks ago we said:

"The cigar manufacturer of to-day is not

beholden to the packer of a certain style

of seed leaf wrappers to comply with the

demands of his trade. With proper man-

ipulation he is enabled to make use of

any kind of seed tobacco, even for the

best seed and Havana cigars."

The packers now at Lancaster will re-

ceive a blow for their heedless operations,

which, however, will be a wholesome les-

son to them and the leaf trade. As an

apology for their doings, they offer the

still questionable fact that the '79 Pen-

sylvania tobacco is miraculously fine. Es-

pecially the size is spoken of as being

something marvelous; so much so that it

said, that one case of these wrappers is

equal to two cases of any old crop wrap-

pers. Granting this to be true, it is the

more inexcusable on their part to pay such

large prices for it. Because, if of this gi-

gantic tobacco there are only 20,000 cases

of Pennsylvania (taking the figures of one

who has gleefully invested in this kind of

tobacco) they are equal to 40,000 cases

of the usual style of wrapper. In fact the

Pennsylvania crop, which is estimated

at 70,000 cases, will then represent to

90,000 if not more. One of our most

prominent cigar manufacturing firms is

purchasing heavily in New York state;

another, as we have noted above, has

already secured 1,500 cases of '79 Wiscon-

sin; and this is invested largely in '79

Connecticut. Now, if all the good prop-

erties claimed for the '79 Pennsylvania

really exist, why don't these manufactur-

ers, instead of purchasing Wisconsin,

State or Connecticut, participate in the

yielding '79 Pennsylvania? Why in

other branches of trade prices of goods

were and are advancing, the leaf trade
