BATHOLOMEW ON LA GRIPPE.

The Effects of the Disease Described. How to Secure Immunity.

The Medical News of Philadelphia publishes an exhaustive article on influenza (La Grippe) by Prof. Batholomew.

"Influenza comes suddenly and goes as quickly. The least robust of any age and women seem to be the most susceptible.

"With the first access of the nasal and faucal irritation comes the chilliness, which is followed by some feverishness, with more pronounced symptoms of light chills, headache, weakness and soreness of the members, especially of the larger joints.

"The best manner of securing immunity is by the inhalation of sulphurous vapors.

"The internal remedy most desirable is atropine in solution—two grains in one to five drops, the minimum being for little children, after first dentition.

"The second best is quinine. In one to five drops, the minimum being for little children, after first dentition.

"My own conviction is that as a prophylactic the combination of cinchonidine with salicylic acid is preferable to quinine.

"The depressing and melancholy it is probable that atropine will do better.

"The depressing headache, joint pains and weakness, antipyretic, acetamide, salicylic acid, and other germicides and antiseptics will, no doubt, be found useful."

NEW HAMPSHIRE'S EXECUTIVE ESSAYS TO ENFORCE PROHIBITORY LAWS.

Recent Heinous Crimes He Traces to the Use of Liquors and Decides to Facilitate War Against Saloons.

CONCORD, N. H., Dec. 23.—Gov. Goodell today issued the following extraordinary proclamation:

"In view of the various heinous crimes which have been committed in our state within the past few weeks directly traceable to the use of intoxicating liquors, in the sale of which the criminal laws have been flagrantly violated, now, therefore, I warn all persons engaged in this illegal and dangerous traffic to desist therefrom immediately, and I call upon the attorney general of the state, the solicitors and sheriffs of the counties, mayors of cities and selectmen, and all other officers throughout the state, and upon all good citizens of every party to unite in one supreme effort to close up and suppress every liquor saloon of every description without delay or compromise."

Numerous decisions of our supreme court attest the constitutionality of our prohibitory liquor laws. Let them be vigorously enforced that our people may enjoy the great benefits which are sure to follow. And I cannot refrain from urging all churches, temperance organizations and all persons who desire the best good of our commonwealth to redouble their efforts to promote personal sobriety and temperance amongst our people."
