VINITA, I. T., Aug. 12, 1892. EDITOR REGISTER.—The "Arkansaw Travellers" are still on deck! We left our camp on Indian creek last Monday morning about 7:30 and headed our horses southwest.

At noon on Monday we reached a small town, Noel, on the Cowskin river. The place has a good reputation as a fishing ground so we camped here and spent half a day catching a few measly minnows.

Tuesday morning, bright and early—and to our extreme delight—we left the Cowskin river and by 10:30 reached Sulphur Springs, Ark., where we decided to stop for dinner.

We left Sulphur Springs shortly after dinner, and again turned southward. It has been excessively dry in this part of Arkansas and it is pitiable to see the crops all burned up by the terrible drought.

Tuesday night we camped in Decatur, Ark. We got in town just as a large political picnic of the Democrats and Pops was breaking up.

We reached Siloam Springs, Ark., at noon on Wednesday and remained in camp there the remainder of the day and the night to receive mail.

Thursday night we camped in Southwest City, Mo., Friday night at Carey's Ferry. Here some of us had the pleasure of seeing our first ferry boat, and Saturday night and Sunday found us in Vinita, I. T.
