Neither do I blame them for giving our support for the jobs they wanted, but I have since then awakened to the fact that when I was a live, hunting officer in the republican party that I was giving my best efforts to an organization that cared nothing for the will of the people.

The direct primary and a united vote of working men and farmers will go a long way towards curing our troubles.

Let us hold our direct primary and elect the men we want, because they will do the things we want done. There will be nothing to it when working men and farmers vote and think together.
