THE WALDRAN INJUNCTION.

Interesting Decision of Chancellor Smith. CHANCERY COURT—Wm. M. Smith, Chancellor—Yesterday, in chambers, Chancellor Smith rendered the following interesting decision in the injunction case of Burditt et al. vs. Waldran.

After much reflection and deliberation I conclude it to be my duty to overrule the motion for an injunction in this case. The following reasons have influenced my action:

I may here remark that it is clearly established that Judge Waldran had not been three years a resident of the State before the appointment; but even if there were no doubt on the legal question, (and I must say that there is very little in my mind) still it is not shown beyond doubt that the defendant has been excluded from the office.

I must confess that this record exhibits a deplorable state of affairs, and has grieved me greatly. To say the least of it, and I feel it my duty to say this much, it exhibits a want of judicial propriety and respect for the law, which is alarming.

I confess to great embarrassment in this case. I have earnestly desired to discharge faithfully a very delicate duty. I have acted in great doubt, and the very fact of the decision is a reason why the injunction should not issue.

I have also been influenced by another consideration. The Legislature has certainly the right to elect a Judge of the Court without an impeachment. A Judge or Attorney-General may be removed from office by a resolution of the House.


