THE TENNESSEE.

Description of the Ship and Her Fitness for Sea - Reasons Why She Should Not Yet be Heard From.

From the New York Herald. As there seems to be some uneasiness about the steamship Tennessee, on board, a short description of the vessel and the opinion of high naval authorities here concerning her will be of interest to the public. The Tennessee was formerly the Madawaska, and was built as a fast ship to overtake the swift blockade runners. She was on her trial trip, under the command of Commander Rowe, on January 14, 1867. She was as fast as a steamship, and was out about six and a half days, during four days of which she was in a series of hurricanes and gales, but all her sails blown out of the rigging, and her hull subjected to a severe test; she made no water, however, but shipped a good many seas, being too low in the water and an open-decked ship, her engines and boiler were all water-logged.
