

THE CITY AND THE STREET CONTRACTORS.

It is said that an adjustment of accounts between the city and street contractors is now contemplated, and that the basis of an agreement has probably been made. RAILROAD TROUBLE.

Col. W. A. Jones obeyed the order, but returned in force and a slight disturbance ensued. Both parties have been largely reinforced and trouble is imminent. The management claim that Mr. Johnson had no authority for his conduct.
