At Terre Haute, yesterday, the thirteenth annual convocation of the Indiana Sunday-school union opened its session.

As far as heard from the big city of London has contributed only seven thousand five hundred dollars for the relief of the St. Johns sufferers.

Ex-Governor Packard, of Louisiana, was overland at Des Moines, Iowa, last night, and it was feared "the story he did tell," in response to a wreath.

Up to the present time the city of Boston has contributed nearly twenty-five thousand dollars for the relief of the sufferers by the conflagration at St. Johns, New Brunswick.

At a meeting of the officers, clerks, and employees of the internal revenue bureau in Washington yesterday, resolutions were adopted to the memory of the late Commissioner Daniel D. Pratt were adopted.

In the Spanish congress, yesterday, the minister of foreign affairs announced that he had taken steps for concluding a commercial treaty with the United States, in order to obtain a rebate on imported articles.

FIVE HUNDRED people applied for bread and clothing to the relief committee in St. Johns, New Brunswick, yesterday. The city authorities are preparing to erect temporary structures for shelter to the homeless.

A CAREFULLY prepared list of losses by the conflagration at Marblehead, Massachusetts, makes the aggregate on buildings, \$358,000; loss to coal-pans, machinery, stock, furniture, etc., \$170,000. Total loss, \$528,000.

A SPECIAL election for seventeen members of the State legislature took place in Charleston county, South Carolina, yesterday, resulting in the success of the Democratic ticket, consisting of fourteen whites and three colored, without opposition.

THE Southern express company recovered twelve thousand five hundred dollars from the Citizens bank of New Orleans yesterday in a suit for back freight on undelivered packages, the bank confessing judgment before the United States court of that city.

THE Anti-slavery society of England yesterday benefited William Lloyd Garrison in London, at which Mr. Garrison took occasion to say that he had the utmost confidence in Grant's southern policy, but Hayes had taken a false step in yielding the south up to home rule.

THE secretary of war directs that enlisted men be sold to officers and subalterns on credit, giving the proper receipts. This order is issued on account of no appropriation for the support of the army having been made. A similar order to enable them to obtain fuel, etc., from the quartermaster's department will be issued.

BOSTON put the big pot into the little one yesterday on the occasion of the grand reception to Mr. Hayes and his party. The weather was favorable, and the streets were crowded with spectators. Business was suspended, and the buildings on each side of the streets through which the procession passed were profusely decorated, while all the vessels in the harbor were clothed with colors.

FIRST BUSINESS of the Nashville Merchants Exchange.

NASHVILLE, June 26.—The Merchants exchange, lately organized, and including all departments of trade, was formally opened today, in presence of a full representation of the commercial interests of the city. The first sale on change was the first receipt of Tennessee wheat to be delivered to-morrow. The opening bid was \$1 25. The competition became brisk, free transportation being promised. The lot was finally knocked down at \$1 75. The wheat was raised from Henry Hart's farm, four miles from the city, and offered on change by Hart & Hendry, and purchased by M. Alden & Wheeler. Another lot of tough Alabama wheat, offered by Gilbert, Parkes & Co., was sold to B. L. Alden. One hundred and twenty-five bushels of corn and other products were made, and the new organization starts on its business life under most auspicious circumstances.

Successful raid on Whiskey Distilleries in East Tennessee.

WASHINGTON, June 26.—Revenue Agent Bowen reports to the commissioner of internal revenue from Knoxville that he has made a successful raid on the distilleries in Hancock county, capturing two boys and two girls, the distillers, and half a dozen smaller offenders, and destroying two stills, fourteen still-houses, eighty-four tubs of beer, about eight thousand gallons of beer, and seventy-five gallons of whiskey.

DISASTROUS CYCLONE.

Additional Particulars of the Destruction to Property and Crops Throughout the Northwest by the Storm on Monday.

Passenger Train Blown from the Track—Several Persons Seriously Injured—Thousands of Dollars Damage to Crops.

Several Persons Killed and Injured by Falling Buildings—Cattle Destroyed—Buildings Demolished—Bridges Washed and Blown Away—Etc., Etc.

DAYTON, O., June 25.—A heavy storm passed over the city about five o'clock this morning, and did considerable damage, it is reported to have done a great deal of damage to the crops and property in the neighboring country.

ONIDA, ILL., June 25.—A heavy rain-storm passed over this city at half-past ten o'clock this morning, and did considerable damage to the crops and property. It is estimated that fifty thousand dollars' worth of property was destroyed. Among the buildings damaged were the churches of the Universalist and Baptist churches, P. Miller & Co.'s flouring-mill, the hardware store and warehouse of E. Marsh. Many beautiful shade-trees are totally destroyed. No lives were lost.

KANKAKEE, ILL., June 25.—The Cincinnati express, due here at twelve o'clock noon, was blown off the track three miles north of this city by a storm of wind, terrific lightning and rain accompanying it. Several persons were hurt quite badly, but none were killed. Mr. Shafter, conductor on the C. and N. road, was in the lead, and his wife is hurt most seriously, having her hip crushed. Conductor Lewis, of the train, was also hurt, and his wife, Mrs. Kentland, was hurt seriously in the head, and is in bed. Several other persons were badly injured. The railroad company is taking care of them. The engine came near going off, it rode some distance on one side. The tender to it was blown off.

CHICAGO, June 25.—The damage in Chicago will probably not exceed twenty thousand dollars, and the loss to the city will be in broken glass, unroofed houses, broken fences and signs, and overturned vehicles. Two small houses on the north side were destroyed by the wind, and the houses on Douglas street were blown down. A carpenter, named Fred Kessler, who was working on the corner of Third and Dear streets, was thrown out of the second story by the force of the wind, and struck on his head, and is now in bed.

CHICAGO, June 25.—The storm of last night was very general throughout the west. It was first heard of at Chicago yesterday afternoon, and extended north of St. Louis and south of Kansas city, and over the State of Iowa, and reached the Gulf of Mexico, and south several washes occurred in the railroads. In Iowa the rain-fall exceeded two inches, causing some of the bridges to be washed away. The O. and N. W. railroad had a bridge washed out near Logansport. At Bear River, near the mouth of the Missouri river, the town and all the buildings were destroyed. The rain-fall here exceeded one inch and a half. A large cotton bridge was blown down, and a cotton field, entailing considerable loss.

Additional particulars of the storm show that it did most damage in a western Iowa, west of the Missouri river. The trains have been delayed east and south by the wet tracks and mud.

TOLEDO, June 25.—The storm this afternoon was very severe in this vicinity. At Columbus Grove, the crops were reported badly damaged. The residence of Mr. Pangle, who was killed, was blown down, and nearly one hundred stores and dwellings in Champlain and Urbana were destroyed. All great business was totally broken, and a great deal of property was lost. A large quantity of rain fell.

ATCHISON, June 26.—No damage was done in northern Kansas by the recent storms, and the crop prospects were never better in this season of the year. Wheat is ready for cutting, and corn is growing very finely.

IN SOUTH AMERICA. WASHINGTON, June 25.—A report received at the state department to-day, from the United States consul at Buenos Ayres, in which, under date of June 24th, ultimo, he gives information concerning the heavy and most disastrous rain-storm that ever occurred in that country, the duration was almost continuous for several days throughout the province of Buenos Ayres. The pampas were everywhere flooded and drowned out. The damage to stock and sheep-farms has been immense. Our consul says that the loss of cattle, horses and sheep can only be estimated, but they must amount to hundreds of thousands, if not a million head.

EASTERN WAR NEWS.

The Turks Have Achieved a Great Victory Near Erzeroum—A Fresh Attack on Batoum Expected.

Turks Retreating from the Danube—Another Passage of the Danube Contemplated—Movements Very Mysterious.

The Bombardment of Rastchuk Continued and More Terrific—Eighteen Hundred People Killed in the Streets.

NEW YORK, June 26.—A Constantinople dispatch says that the Turkish army has won a great victory, and has taken one thousand Russian prisoners. A fresh attack on Batoum is expected, and the Turkish army is reported to be in the neighborhood of that city.

ERZEROU, June 26.—The report recently published of a conspiracy to blow up the Suez canal was based on authentic information, but the cabinet officers have taken measures to prevent any such attempt on land, while a sea police is being organized under the command of an English officer.

PARIS, June 26.—The Russian telegraphic agency, in contradicting the rumored news that the Russian army was preparing to cross the Danube, says that Russia will loyally keep her promise. The peace of Europe is perfectly assured, and the Russian army is far from impeding it, will consolidate it.

PESTH, June 26.—In the lower house of the Hungarian diet today Count Oppony and Herr Kallay urged the necessity of maintaining the integrity of Turkey. Herr Lizza, premier minister, said that the cabinet council had decided against the occupation of foreign territory or the mobilization of troops, but that Austria-Hungary would not see the Turkish army crossing the Danube by a foreign power.

BUDAPEST, June 26.—The corps under command of General Bismarck, which is advancing as quickly as possible up the line of Tchernovoda and Kustendje railway, and after several days' fighting, the Turkish army will force a passage higher up stream.

THIRTEEN Turkish shells struck the hospital at Rastchuk, and killed several of the Turkish soldiers. The Turkish army has evacuated the Russian soldiers occupied Hirzova.

THE czar has left St. Petersburg. Prince Gortschakoff arrived here accompanied by the staff of the Russian chancellor.

CONSTANTINOPLE, June 26.—The Turkish news under the name of the Constantinople of the Russians at Batoum. The same paper states that Suleiman Pasha has entered Constantinople, and that the command of the Turkish army is now in the hands of the Russian general, and finally compelled them to withdraw their batteries, and retreat with a loss of fifteen hundred men.

WASHINGTON, June 26.—General M'Dowell has been instructed by General Sherman to move his Indian army as far as possible, and to pay no attention whatever to the boundary lines of the different military commands, but to march straight on to the Indian country, and to take possession of the country as he goes.

ST. JOHNS, N. B., June 26.—A press dispatch from Portland has the following: "A dispatch from a special correspondent, just received, says that the Indian army, under the command of General Howard, is now in the neighborhood of the mouth of the St. Lawrence river, and is reported to be between Little Salmon and Snake rivers. Howard's army is reported to be about twenty-five miles south of Mount Idaho."

LONDON, June 26: The boiler of the Ravennae iron-works, at Tunstall, exploded today, killing eight and wounding thirty persons.

BERLIN, June 26: The weekly statement of the Imperial Bank of Germany shows a surplus of one million six hundred thousand marks.

BOSTON, June 26: By the explosion of the boiler of the tugboat Herbert, William Farrell, engineer, and one Farrell, chief hand, were killed.

CHESTER, Penn., June 26: W. H. Johnson, of Delaware county, in a fit of jealousy, last night shot his cousin, John Worral, and killed himself.

BALTIMORE, June 26: James Gardner and W. G. Groves were arrested at Baltimore, Maryland, in suspicion of being murderers of Rev. J. M. Fryday, pastor of the Lutheran Wesleyan church, whose body was found in the canal there June 1st.

BRALIA, June 26: The Turkish army has retreated toward Medje, on the line of the Kustendje railway, so that the whole north coast of Bulgaria may be abandoned. It is only likely that they will make a stand this side of Silistria. The fourteenth corps under the command of the Russian general, who is marching south, will be joined by the rapidly corps, now in the direction of Rastchuk, and will march south to the greatest advantage. It is not yet known whether this army will work as a column of advance between the Danube and Silistria; it seems probable, however, that to these two corps may fall the duty of reducing Silistria, and perhaps Shumla. It further seems likely that another passage of the Danube will be attempted somewhere between Giurgevo and Turna-Maguelni within the next few days.

CINCINNATI, June 26.—At a meeting to-day of the stockholders of the Common carrier company, formed to co-operate with the Cincinnati Southern railroad company, the subscriptions were reduced from four hundred and seventy thousand to one hundred and twenty thousand dollars. This action was taken on account of the inability of the Common carrier company to obtain satisfactory pledges from the trustees of the railroad. The members of the syndicate who held the controlling interest in the stock, reduced the subscription from thirty-two thousand to five thousand dollars, each.
