

ESTABLISHED 1840. THE ENGLAND'S MUSS. The Difference of Opinion Between the Russian and British Cabinets Makes the Fate of the Congress Uncertain—The Comments of the Times.

VIENNA, March 23.—The Hungarian delegation, to-day, Count Andrássy said it was not the intention of the cabinet to meet at the end of March, but meanwhile some preliminary questions had arisen between England and Russia, and it is impossible to state the date of meeting with certainty.

LONDON, March 23.—The British cabinet requires a declaration from Russia that the communication of peace to the powers is equivalent to its formal presentation to the congress.
