THE STATE OF PARTIES.

It is then the political tyro, like the vanquished and disheartened soldiers, grow weary of the contest and are ready to surrender. But time is a wonderful inventor; it cures and cures the defeated party, and it cures it as surely as it heals the widow's heart. Indeed, it often makes men more desperate and determined on victory. When, in 1840, Harrison rode into the presidency on the popular tide that overwheeled the Democratic party, it was predicted that there would be no rally, no restoration of the party founded by Jefferson. But at that election the Democrats were restored to power. The Whigs triumphed in 1848 by electing Taylor; but four years afterwards the Democrats ascended to power by electing Pierce to the presidency. The defeat of Greeley in 1872 was a terrible blow to the Democratic party; but it rallied, and at the next election elected Tilden by a majority of nearly three hundred thousand. The defeat of Hancock at the last presidential election was followed by the same demoralization. But the Democratic party is still in the field ready for another contest. It will again be confronted by the Republican party. There will be no third party in the next election, for such parties seldom grow into a success, and when they do, it is a very slow process. Since 1840 there have been three parties in the country, the Democratic and Republican; and the overshadowing issue forced on the people by slavery alone made the Republican party the majority. The Democratic party, though in a minority since 1860, keeps its organization compact. The next president of the United States will, therefore, unquestionably, either be a Democrat or Republican, and the probability is that the Democrats will triumph in such an election. Sectionalists will be proscribed out of the canvass, and without this issue the Republican party will be without life and vitality. The war between the Republican and Democratic parties is irreconcilable. Grant, Arthur, Conkling & Co. are determined to rule or ruin, and as the possibilities are they will rule, ruin is inevitable. Indeed, the factions in the Republican party each other more than they do the Democratic party. It is plain to be seen that Blaine and the peculiar friends of Garfield are uneasy and determined to hold it a Stewart, whose teachings inspired the assassination of Garfield, should be nominated for the presidency.
