

MOTHER OF SLAIN CHILD COLLAPSES WHILE TESTIFYING

Mrs. Laura Bailey Is Carried From Millville Court-room as George Hawn Is Arraigned.

MILLVILLE, N. J., Dec. 31.—The mother of six-year-old Beatrice Bailey, shot and killed on Tuesday by George Hawn, a jealous suitor of her 17-year-old son, collapsed in the hearing room of Justice Oliver here today when Hawn was arraigned on the charge of murder.

Hawn was held without bail by the Justice for the action of the Grand Jury. The hearing was dramatic. When the charge was read to the man and he was asked if he had a lawyer he declared he knew nothing about the law, that he never meant to kill any one and had never before been in trouble.

Mrs. Laura Bailey, of Millville, mother of the slain child, was called to testify shortly after the hearing started. She sold of being summoned to Bucks County, the home of Mrs. Alice Pettit, her mother, where Beatrice was visiting, and of finding the child dead.

TWO SAVED FROM FLAMES

Mother and Daughter Rescued When Barrington, N. J., Home Burns.

BARRINGTON, N. J., Dec. 31.—Two persons were rescued from a fire in the home of John Anderson shortly after 10 o'clock this morning. Several hundred men and women formed a bucket brigade and by heroic work kept the fire from spreading to the Barrington railroad station and other adjoining buildings. The damage was \$500.

Anderson, an employee of the Reading Railway, was in Camden at the time. Mrs. Anderson and her 9-year-old daughter were trapped on the second floor and carried down the ladders by the volunteer firemen.


