




THINGS AND PERSONS OF NOTE IN THE WORLD'S NEWS DAY BY DAY AS REPORTED BY THE CAMERA


ONE OF JOFFRE'S "NIBBLERS"


DAUGHTER OF CROWN PRINCE YALE SENIOR'S BRIDE
