




SIDELIGHTS ON THE NEWS OF THE DAY AS GATHERED BY THE EVER-PRESENT CAMERA MAN

Congressman J. H. Davis has been famous for 25 years because of his antipathy to the white collar of respectability. But he put one on the other day, to the astonishment of the Capital.





