Final instructions to the more than 2600 selected men who leave for Camp Meade tomorrow were given this afternoon at the various district headquarters.


More than 2600 men will entrain tomorrow for Camp Meade from the Baltimore and Ohio station. Twenty-fourth and Chestnut streets, Broad and Washington avenue and other places. The draftees represent the 45 per cent quota from twenty districts in the central, southern and western part of the city.

Public schools, police stations, engine houses have been chosen in the various draft districts as the starting point for the various neighborhood armies. In those districts where the mobilization point is near the railroad station the men will march, but in many districts arrangements have been made to carry them with dignity in automobiles.
