COMMENTING on the proposal that the city operate its own coal mine to supply the needs of the public schools, Secretary Dick, of the Board of Education, points out that legislation would be required to permit the use of funds for this purpose.

Mr. Davis, chief of the Water Bureau, when interviewed by the Evening Public Ledger on Monday relative to a new masonry dam for Fairmount Park, suggested the possibility of a hydro-electric plant.
