ALL CANNING STEPS ARE IMPORTANT

An Expert Gives Details of Process Step by Step—Wise Cannors Read Directions Carefully, Heed Every Rule and Do Not Trust to Pot Luck—Aim to Get Produce Into Jars as Quickly as Possible

THE first step in home canning of vegetables or fruits is to make sure that all the needed apparatus is handy and in condition for immediate use.

Use Fresh, Sound Products: The fruits or vegetables to be canned must be fresh, sound, and neither too green nor too ripe.

Preparation of Fruits and Vegetables: Select sound fresh fruits and vegetables and carefully wash in cold water.

Preparation of Fruits and Vegetables (continued): Wash them by pouring water over the berries or other fruit...

Preparation of Fruits and Vegetables (continued): Pack the jars with water, put the lid on the boiler, and let the jars boil until you can see steam coming from under the lid.

Preparation of Fruits and Vegetables (continued): Remove the jars from the boiler and place them in a cold water bath to cool.

Preparation of Fruits and Vegetables (continued): Wipe the jars with a clean towel and seal them with the caps.
