

COOL MOUNT POCONO ALWAYS ATTRACTS Clean Air, Superb View and Good Hotels Make Ideal Summer Home

Mount Pocono, June 12.—Far up on top of the Pocono Mountains is the famous resort, both winter and summer, known to thousands of people, deeply loved by them, and a spot to which they are now hastening as fast as rail and machine will take them, a village set in the midst of beautiful surroundings, where it is always cool, the air is dry and invigorating, a place which occupies a big spot on the map of the United States, the town of Mount Pocono.

Mount Pocono is but a few hours ride from the big cities of the East and has long been known as a resort. Here thousands go in summer to escape the heat, and many go in winter to hunt and enjoy winter sports of every description.

It is indeed a revelation as one steps from the train to behold such large resort houses and hotels tucked away in the corner of the universe where one could expect to see nothing but barren and tall timber. But it is, instead, one of nature's wonders, a place set aside by nature where her people might enjoy to the full amidst the comforts of civilization which are becoming so popular in the years to go.

Mount Pocono boasts twenty-five resort houses, the largest of them the Mount Pleasant House, accommodating 150. This house is conducted under the management of Messrs. W. A. and H. C. Denlinger.

Other popular houses in this section are Mount Lake House, The Knobs Inn, Laurel Grove, Spruce Mountain House, The Belvedere, The Glenmere, The Overlook, Lewis Falls House, Glen Cairn Villa, Wildwood Cottage, The View Farm, The Poplars, Monomoch Inn, Pleasant Ridge House, Henry Price House, Bon Air Lodge, Lake View Cottage and Mountain Laurel Cottage.

Stroudsburg, the county seat, although a city of 10,000, is also a favored resort town. Three miles from the Water Gap and a good hour's ride from Mt. Pocono, it lies in a wide valley which enjoys all the beauties of nature. Two trout streams run through the town. There is a half-mile race track, on which races are staged every week. Baseball park and fair grounds, tennis courts, excellent bathing, golf courses ten minutes away, paved streets, wide and bordered by old maple trees, some of them a hundred years old, add to its allurement.

The sites of two forts of the war of 1812 are to be seen on its main street thus showing it is an historic town. The McMillan's Fall in the center of the town is a thing of beauty, and two railroads and a trolley direct from the Quaker City make hourly connections from all points.

Stately resort houses accommodate thousands over the busy week-end. For this town is a mecca for tourists. Among the leading houses are the Shickel Inn, C. H. Palmer, proprietor, capacity 100; Indian Queen, H. H. Harris, proprietor; The Pennine, Washington House, Lehigh Terrace, Maplehurst, Hotel Fenner, Oak Grove, Hillside House, Vineyard Cottage, Bushkill Farms Camp.

Shickel Inn-Delaware has in the Buckwood Inn one of the leading hotels of the county, a modern fireproof structure which accommodates 400. Its principal attraction is its wonderful eighteen-hole golf course, which rivals those of the South, and which takes one over a vast expanse of territory, the scenery ever changing, and one of the drives across the Delaware river. The Buckwood Inn was built along the banks of the Delaware and the grounds are marvellous beauty. C. Worthington of Lakewood, N. J., are the capable and successful managers.

There are numerous other houses scattered about the county all doing a fine business and all bringing greater credit to old Monroe each year.

All Amusements Handy The Mount Pleasant House has every amenity at its patrons' disposal, and in a few minutes walks are famous streams, mountain paths, tennis courts, golf links, good roads for auto and horseback riding and a center where these roads is surely an exhilarating sport.

From Mount Pocono the view reaches 5,000 square miles of mountain and valley in Pennsylvania, New York and Jersey. Well shaded rhododendrons take one to the summits of the mountains where one can see as far as eyes can reach.



of the Albion, Sunset Hill, the Madison, the Monmouth, the Carleton, and many other houses. Houses already open, among them the New Ocean Hotel, which H. O. Gardner is again conducting, already are entertaining record early June crowds. The hot wave has brought vacationists by the hundreds, and June 1, of course, is the average day for beginning cottage tenancy. Asbury has made unusual preparations for the summer season. Railroads have co-operated with splendid train schedules and today the service is up to the usual June standard. The Jersey Central has added another steamboat to its Sandy Hook route and the through trains which are summer accommodations for the benefit of New York commuters are now on the train schedule. Naval men are here this year in greater number than ever before. Young officers, college boys mostly on furlough after their time in training camps, bring cheer to the ranks of young people. The cottages and goings of these young officers, soldiers and seamen, will be a distinct feature of the summer here. And while thousands of Americans will come to Asbury Park and neighboring resorts for a vacation, there is forecast in the flow of Red Cross branches that the women, even on vacation, propose to devote a consistent part of their recreation time to war work. Asbury Park chapter Red Cross headquarters has gained already many recruits from the summer colony, and volunteers are enrolling for the coming war stamp drive which will feature the New Jersey campaign from now until June 28. Just what form the annual carnivals will take this year is not yet determined, but Mayor Hetrick indicates there will be a patriotic pageant which will include some of the features which have made the fetes of other summers popular. The theatrical season will include the usual dramatic schedule, with several new musical and dramatic offerings listed for their premier here.
