Convention Indorses Soldier in Preference to Governor Lowden

DEMOCRATS FOR WILSON

Pierre, S. D., Dec. 3.—Major General Leonard Wood, President Woodrow Wilson and Governor Leno J. Frrazier, of North Dakota, today had the endorsement for President of the United States of the Republican, Democratic and Nonpartisan League, respectively, of South Dakota. The endorsements were made at the state conventions of the three parties last night under the Richards primary law enacted at the last session of the Legislature.

The Democrats also endorsed Vice President Thomas R. Marshall for a third term, while the Republicans gave their endorsement to Governor Calvin Coolidge, of Massachusetts, for the vice presidency. The Nonpartisan League did not select a candidate for that office.

After candidates for United States senator, representatives in Congress and various state offices had been nominated and platforms adopted, the three conventions adjourned early today.
