The Shannock, according to a dispatch received from there today, was a heavy storm raging at the time and the Deva was virtually helpless on account of boiler trouble. The Shannock's signals were seen by the Deva, which was bound for Havre. The Shannock's captain shifted his course and approached the Deva, and attached a line, towed her to safety. The Shannock was bound from this city for Havre, and sailed nearly four weeks ago. It is believed that she had boiler trouble for several days.


INQUIRY OPENS TOMORROW
