

### DISTILLERY RAID NETS 110 GALLONS

Four Men Escape, but Police Find Complete Plant on Marshall Street

### BARRELS OF MASH TAKEN

Police confiscated 110 gallons of whisky and a complete small distillery in a raid on the second floor of a garage building on Marshall street above Park at 5:30 o'clock this morning.

Two men seen rolling barrels into the yard escaped, as did two others, probably posted as "lookouts," who had fallen asleep. They were awakened and jumped over the fence when police entered the yard.

Among the property found by the raiders was a forty-gallon and a ten-gallon still, twelve barrels of mash, bags of barley, hops and corn, bottles of coloring material, gas stoves, buckets, tanks and wash boilers.

Everything was in one room, which had been fitted up complete by the moonshiners.

Patrolman Harris and Maguire, of the Tenth and Buttonwood streets station, while passing the garage this morning saw the two men rolling out barrels.

While one went to the patrol box to call the station house the other crept up the alley and ran in the yard. The men fled when they saw him.

### SLASHED GIRL RECOVERING

Nellie Mandell, Whose Throat Was Cut by Unknown Man, in Hospital

Nellie Mandell, of 2535 Hunger street, the fifteen-year-old girl who was badly slashed with a razor in the hands of an unknown Negro, will recover, physicians say, although her throat is so slashed that the jugular vein is exposed.

The girl, who is in the Women's Homeopathic Hospital, was walking near Twenty-fifth and York streets Sunday night and was within a few doors of her home when she was seized from behind by a tall man. Although warned by the man not to scream, the girl shouted for help, and as she did the man drew the razor across her throat. Her fingers were also cut.
