

GREY INVOKES NEW SPIRIT AT PARLEY

Calls for Abandonment of Secret Diplomacy and Treaties

PATRIOTISM AS KEYNOTE

London, Nov. 11.—Failure by the Washington Armament Conference to attain the ends for which it was summoned would be a great disaster. Viscount Grey declared in the Westminster Gazette.

Recalling that it has been said that the delegates to the Conference should leave the old diplomacy behind them in Europe, the former Foreign Minister asks whether the old diplomacy was the cause of troubles, or whether it was rather the result of troubles. The secret treaties which were often declared to be the evil of the old diplomacy were not, he maintains, necessary to any part of that system.

"What is needed at Washington," he declares, "is not a change of method, but a change in the point of view. If the latter be there, the old methods will disappear, but not otherwise."

Viscount Grey declared his absolute belief that those who summoned the Conference were animated by the high aspirations of a patriotism larger than national patriotism, and that the Conference had an entirely honorable and pure origin.

"When they come to close quarters," he asks, however, "will the Government of the United States and the other

governments be able to keep on this high plane? It is the most difficult of tasks to keep heights which the soul is competent to gain. They must do their part. All we can do is to help create the favorable atmosphere to make them feel the encouraging expectation, the readiness to follow and rise if they show us the heights."

This line of thought leads him to a discussion of public opinion. While he admits that this is often rightly blamed for being apathetic, inert, selfish and

willing to tolerate poor policy on the part of its governments, he inquires whether, if it were individual, it would not sometimes ask its governments to give it "the great appeal; the great opportunity," and adds:

"We have seen what a response there can be to such an appeal in the cause of the war. After experiencing this war, will not one or more of the big democracies have a great opportunity to show how it can respond in the cause of peace?"

\$15,000 IN LIQUOR SEIZED

Mahanoy City Saloon Raided by Police and State Troopers

Mahanoy City, Pa., Nov. 11.—Seven barrels and seventy-two cases of whiskey, valued at \$15,000, were seized in the home of Michael Gavula, this city, early today by Chief of Police A. P. McLaughlin, assisted by County Detective Stanley Miraglio and two State troopers. The officers took the liquor

to the borough building for confiscation. McLaughlin and Miraglio went into the Gavula saloon and ordered two whiskeys, the former drinking his and the latter placing his in a bottle. The officers then announced they were there to make a raid under direction of District Attorney Cyrus Palmer, of

Shuylkill County. They went to the rear of his home and Gavula states they battered down three partitions before they reached the whiskey. Gavula took his case to the Sheriff, stating that he had been held up by the chief of police because he, Gavula, was active in last Tuesday's election.
