

FIREMEN RESCUE FAMILY AT BLAZE

Use Ladder at 895 North Sixth Street When Smoke Fills Stairway

GIRL GIVES ALARM

Firemen arrived at the home of Isaac Oswald, 805 North Sixth street, early this morning just in time to carry the family, including three small children, down a ladder to safety when flames on the first floor had the descent from the upper story cut off.

The Oswalds were awakened about 2 o'clock by the cries of Miss Hannah Davidoff, of 901 North Sixth street, directly across the street, who was awakened by the crash of a window broken by the flames.

When Mr. Oswald tried to get his family out of the house he found that the stairway, the only descent in the ground, was filled with dense smoke. The family then rushed to the windows and cried for help. Meanwhile an alarm had been sent in and the firemen arrived in a short time.

The blaze started among some mattresses in the rear of a furniture store that Mr. Oswald conducts on the first floor of the two-story brick building. Firemen confined the flames to the one floor. The damage was estimated at \$1000. Origin of the blaze is undetermined.

The youngest of the Oswald children is Martin, one year old. The others are Lillian, nine, and Louis, twelve.

DEVEREAUX WILL AIDS POOR

Part of Income of Pine Street Estate to Be Used in Buying of Coal
